HOPE'S SAVINGS GROUP MODEL

Developed in partnership with local churches, savings groups provide vulnerable families with access to a safe place to save, small loans from their pooled savings, and a community to care for each other's needs. Where poverty has brought loneliness and isolation, savings groups foster Christ-centered community and support.

PARTNER SPOTLIGHT

In 2019, the **Anglican Diocese of Mount Kilimanjaro** based in Arusha, Tanzania, partnered with HOPE International to start and support a savings group ministry among its members. In early 2020, amid the COVID-19 pandemic, the diocese launched the ministry in 30 of its churches.

Despite the challenges caused by the pandemic, 32 church facilitators have received training, and 32 savings groups have formed, reaching a total of 671 members. The diocese is looking forward to growing this ministry to 68 savings groups by the end of 2021. Many members testify that groups have become more than a place to save money: They also foster strong relationships in their lives.
